up.

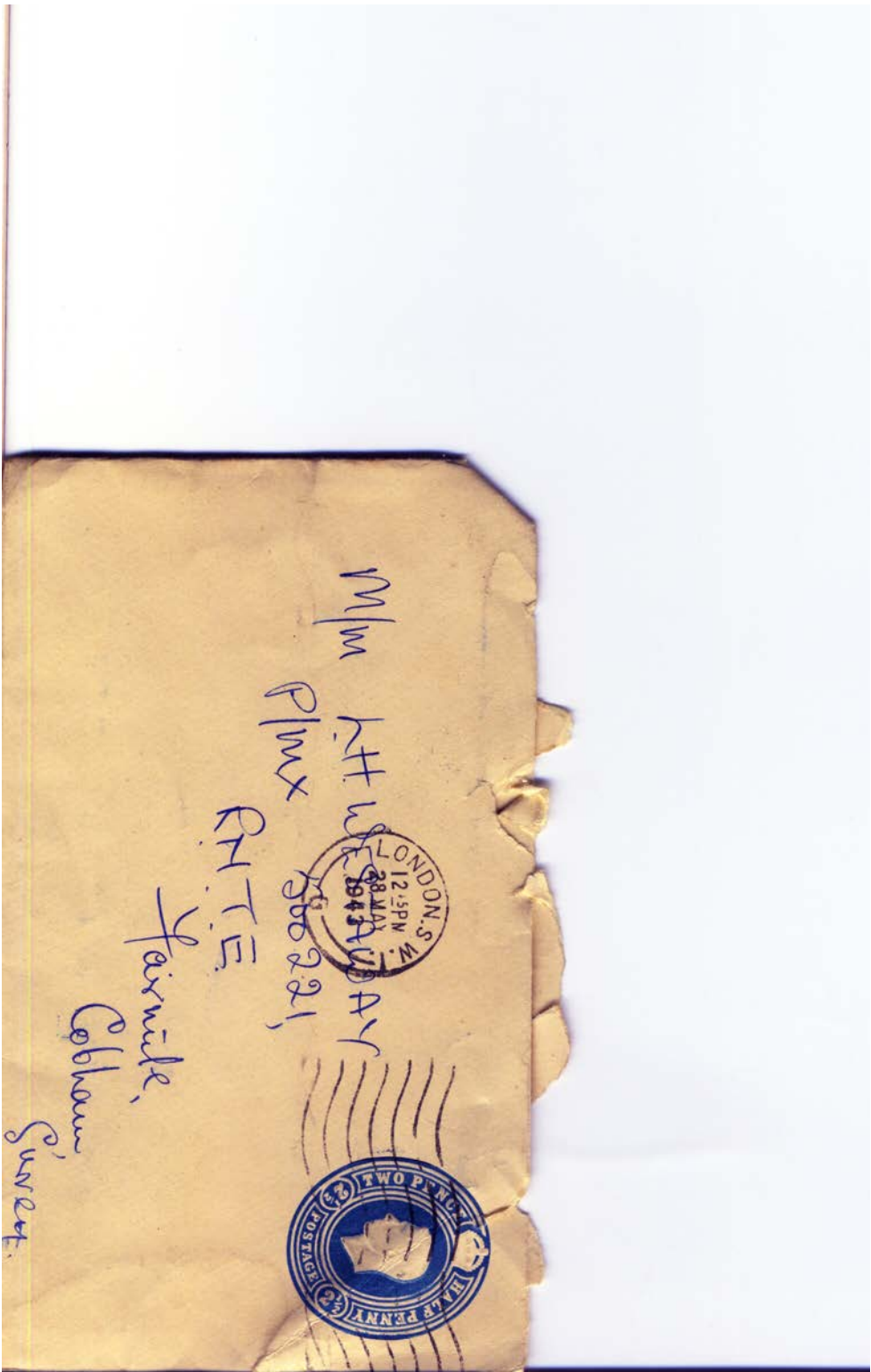
