she is with a nice lot of girls

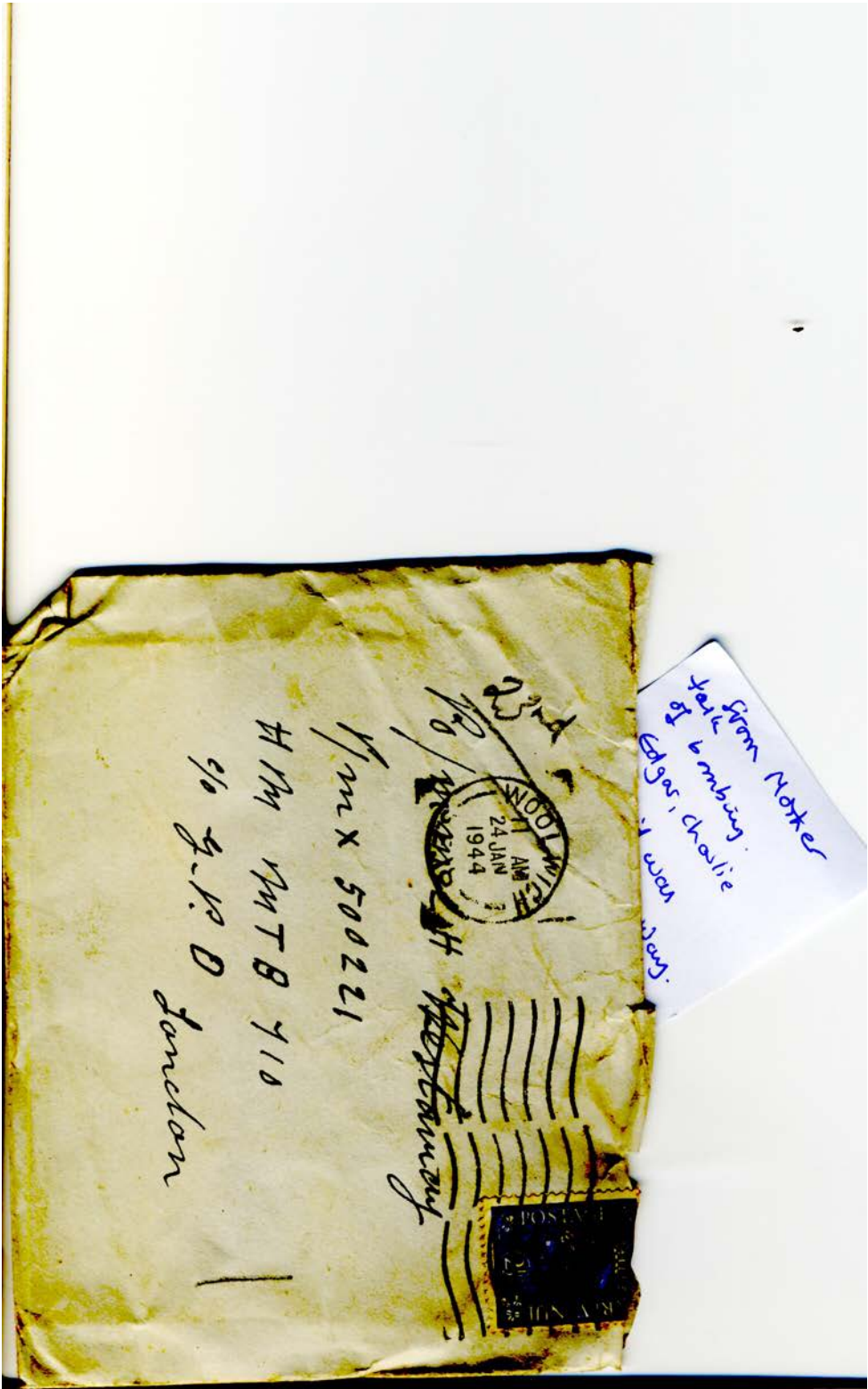
and get good food and eats all
