possibly be yours.

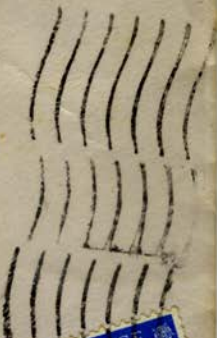
